PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

Licenses:

If applicable, the vendor must have an updated and appropriate Health Department License. (Check with your local Health Department for details). Additionally, food vendors may be inspected by the Hickman County Health Department officials at various times during the event. Questions pertaining to food issues should be directed to the Hickman County Health Department at 270-653-6610.

Vendor times and dates:

Vending dates begin on Friday April 22 from 5PM to 10PM and Saturday April 23 from 8AM to 8PM. Vendors may choose to set up between 12:00PM to 5:00PM on Friday evening. The festival will end at approximately 8:00pm on Saturday night. Any vendor booths/items left in the park overnight are left at the risk of vendor. The Hickman County Spring Chicken Fest Committee will not be held responsible for any damage or property loss.

Cleanliness:

The Vendors are responsible for their assigned area. It is expected that it be left in the same condition it was found. Vendors selling items containing grease must cover the susceptible area for protection. The preferred method of covering is via plywood or plastic. Grease will not be dumped within the festival area or in any festival receptacle. Trash cans will be provided for the general public. If your booth requires a trashcan, you will need to provide your own. You will be responsible for keeping trash picked up within 20 ft. of your booth area. All trash from your area must be removed on a timely basis.

Parking:

Vendors may drive to their area during the designated times on Friday, April 22, and Saturday, April 23 to unload their items for set up. Set up should be complete by 4:00PM Friday, and 8AM Saturday. **Once set-up is complete, all vehicles must be removed from the area immediately.**

Set-up:

Vendors are responsible for their own tables, canopies, etc. **Please make sure to bring everything that you will need.**

Refunds:

There will be no refunds for rain or other acts, either manmade or natural, beyond the control of the Hickman County Spring Chicken Fest.

Prohibited Sales:

Yard Sale Items



This is a family event therefore,

No alcoholic beverages may be sold.

Play or fake money.

Aerosol cans designed to dispense streamers, paint, etc.

Real or play cigarettes.

Real items of a war-like nature, such as, swords, knives, guns, bows & arrows.

Ethnically offensive items Suggestive female/male posters or any other item of this nature.

Any item, material, or substance illegal in the State of Kentucky.

Equipment:

Each vendor is required to bring your own tables, chairs, backboards, power cords, electricity and water source. Questions about Electric Hook Up should be directed to Vendor Chair, Deena Pittman, 270-653-4301.

Liability:

Vendor covenants that it will protect, defend, hold harmless & indemnify the Event, Owner, and Hickman County Spring Chicken Fest, is not liable for lost, damaged or stolen property.

All vendors must follow the Rules of Participation.

Failure to do so may result in immediate dismissal from the event.

Any application submitted without agreeing to these rules will be automatically refused.
